Photography is allowed in the galleries, mansion, and gardens unless otherwise noted.

- Take photos during your visit and share them on social media using #EastmanMuseum and #GEMEclipse.
- Use of flash, selfie sticks, tripods, lights/reflectors on tripods or stands are prohibited in the galleries, though permitted safely on the grounds.
- NOTE: Photographing the Sun with a smartphone or digital camera without a solar filter could damage the imaging sensor in your device.

Health & Safety

When watching the solar eclipse directly with your eyes, you must look through safe solar eclipse viewing glasses, or use a safe handheld solar viewer, to prevent eye injury and damage.

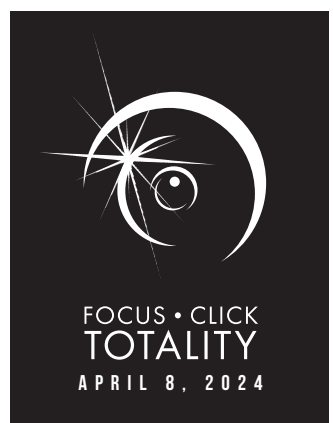
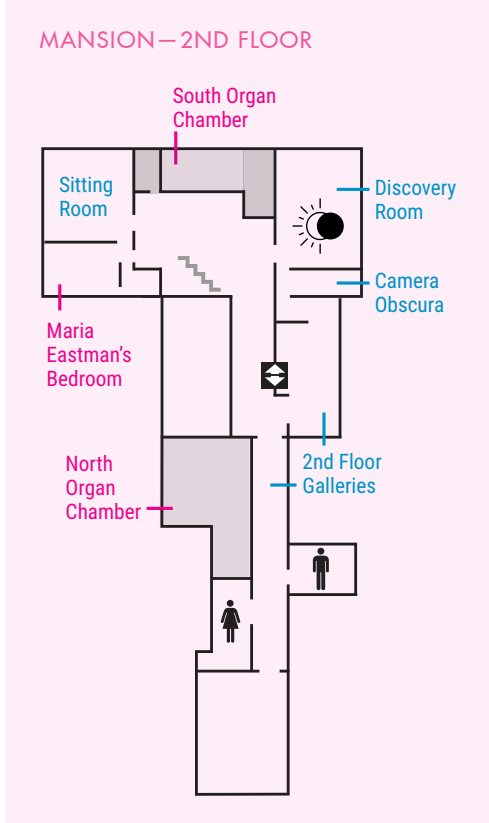
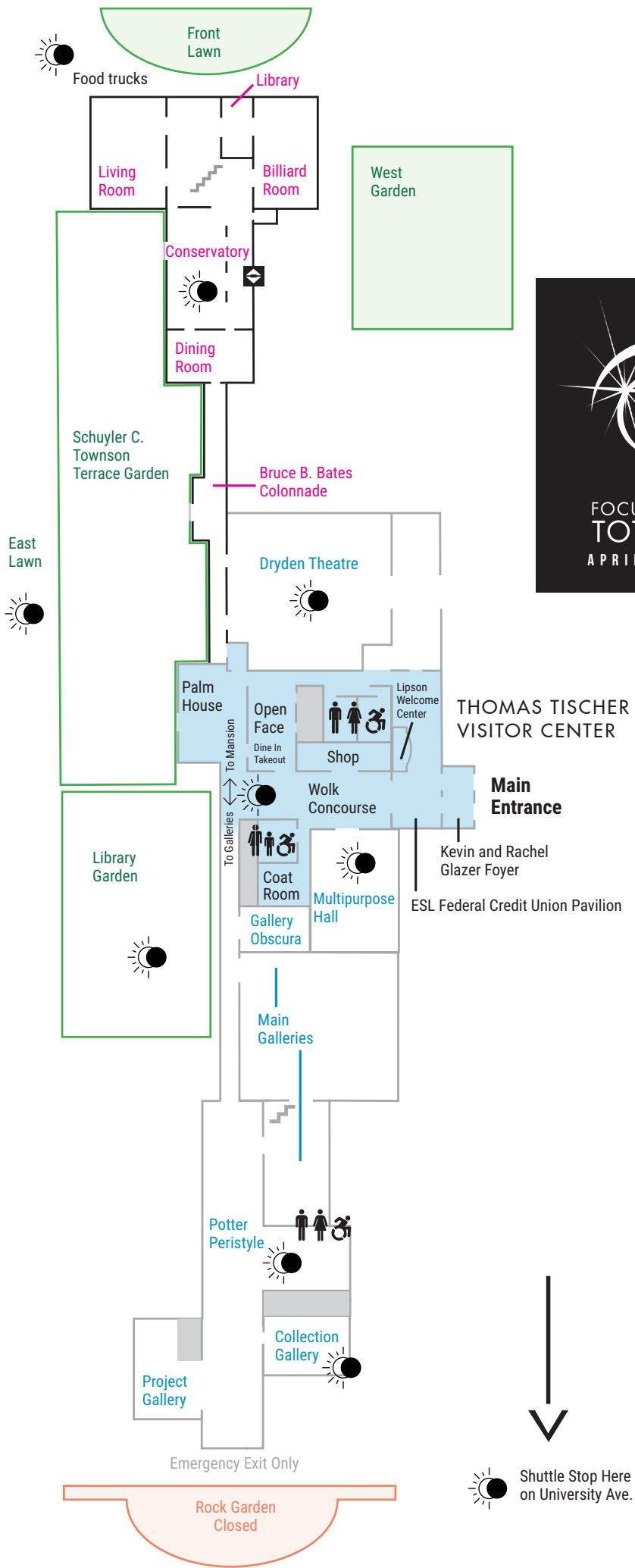
